Follow the instructions below if you need to re-install software on your cabinet. Please be aware that installation will erase all tournament data and cabinet settings. Total installation time is about 25 minutes.

1. With the cabinet powered ON and the game running, press the operator button to launch the Operator Menu.
2. From the Operator Menu, record any cabinet settings that you wish to restore after software installation. For your convenience, write your settings on the included Cabinet Settings Worksheet.
3. To preserve Tournament data for the cabinet, perform the following steps:
 - From the Coin Collection menu, perform a **Do Collection**.
 - From the Registration Options menu, perform a **Force Call**.
4. Open the CD drive and insert the CD labeled **System Recovery Disk**. Reboot the computer.
5. After reboot, the CD will automatically begin the installation process. After about 30 seconds, the monitor will display a status window labeled "Image Center 5.0 - Scripting Progress".
6. When prompted, remove the CD and power cycle the cabinet. **DO NOT put the game CD in the drive yet**. After the reboot, the software will finalize the installation and then the system will automatically reboot again.
7. After the second reboot, you will see a large GLOBAL VR® logo with the Windows Start menu and taskbar. Insert the disk labeled **Game Install Disk 1 of 2**. The disk will run automatically and you will see a progress bar onscreen.
8. When prompted, remove the CD and insert **Game Install Disk 2 of 2**. The CD will run automatically.
9. When Disk 2 finishes, the computer will reboot and the Attract movie will start. Remove the CD.
10. Press the Operator button to launch the Operator Menu and set up your game.
11. If the cabinet was previously registered, select **Restore Cabinet** from the Registration Options screen of the Operator menu to restore settings.
12. Play a game to verify that everything is working properly.
