## Perform the Following Checks Before Converting your System

Installing a new game will not fix existing hardware problems. For optimal performance, check the items listed below before performing the Conversion. Re-check applicable items after the Conversion to verify proper operation. If you find problems, see *Common Repairs for Driving Games*, included in the Conversion Kit, and your Service Manual for repair steps.

Check Item	Before Conversion	After Conversion
Leader light, START button, and brake lights work		
Control panel buttons work and light up		
Steering and force-feedback work (check pot values)		
Gas and brake work (check pot values)		
Shifter works in all gears, if installed (the shifter will be removed, but some signals will be used for other functions)		--
Both coin mechs, bill validator (if installed) and coin meter work		
Speakers work and sound comes from correct speakers		
Monitor image is bright and clear		
Cabinets link properly		
Steering belt and gears are adjusted and not worn		--
Cabinet fans work and air vents are clear		
Wire connections and ground wires are secure		--
Dual force-feedback PCBs have ESD Shock Fix if applicable (see the document <i>Common Repairs for Driving Games</i> )		--
Force-feedback PCB is connected to a PCI USB port		--
Cabinet interior is clean		--
Cabinet exterior is clean and screws are secure		--
Cabinet lighting works		

**Note:** These checks should be performed every 60—90 days to ensure optimal operation.
