HOW TO PLAY

Go Baby Go



breeding

STEP 1



You can breed horses from the existing stable available on any machine or use your own retired horses for breeding. Choose skills from a sire and dam that complement each other so that your foal begins with a nice skill balance.

training

STEP 2



Learn to train your horse in every training exercise, since each exercise trains different abilities. Also, remember to rest your horse every once in a while to get the best racing performance.

feeding

STEP 3



Learn what foods your horse loves to eat. Select foods that increase the ability you wish to improve. There are always four foods that your horse will love to eat, including peppermints.

racing

STEP 4



The only buttons used while racing are the whip and hold buttons. Whipping depletes the horse's stamina from the horse condition meter, while holding adds stamina to the horse condition meter.

The vertical whip effect bar displays the effectiveness of your whips. Each time you whip your horse the bar moves to the left, making your whips less effective. Try not to over whip your horse.

communication

STEP 5



After every race, you'll need to give the horse feedback to improve its racing attitude. Increasing attitude will improve the overall responsiveness of your horse.

running style

Running style determines where on the track your horse is most effective. For instance, whip front runners early in a race, whip closers during the last half of a race and don't whip stalkers until the last corner.



racehorse card

In Career Mode, the machine dispenses your racehorse card at the end of your first session. The racehorse card contains all the statistics and race history of your horse. It can be used in any Breeders' Cup – Tournament Edition™ machine. After 25 races you may retire your horse, after 40 races you must retire the horse. Use the retired racehorse cards to breed your own custom stable.

abilities

- STARTING** Speed out of the gate
- CORNERING** Ability to hold ground in turns
- PASSING** Ability to maneuver around horses
- AGGRESSIVE** Reaction to traffic
- ENDURANCE** Strength at end of longer races
- SPRINTING** Early race speed
